



Maintenance

CLEANING

Clean your fan periodically to maintain its new appearance. Basic cleaning procedures are as follows:


- 1. Use only lukewarm water, Do not use detergent, corrosive or acidic solution.
- 2. Damp the cloth lightly . Use only soft or lint-free cloth to clean the fan. Rough fabric will scratch the surface.
- 3. To cover small scratches, apply a light coat of shoe polish over it
- 4. There is no need to oil the fan.

Troubleshooting

	3. Canopy touches the ceiling	 Check that the canopy is not touching or too close to the ceiling








Install Downrod


1. Insert the downrod assembly to upper and lower canopy




- 2.Insert the downrod to motor assembly.

How To Install Remote Control Holder




Remote Control Coverage




The figure shows the best coverage area. The ideal ceiling height is $3 \sim 4m$. The Remote Control must be pointed to the direction of the fan when in use.

Install Canopy


Raise the upper canopy and tighten it with the set screw. Be sure the upper canopy does not touch the ceiling. Ceiling


