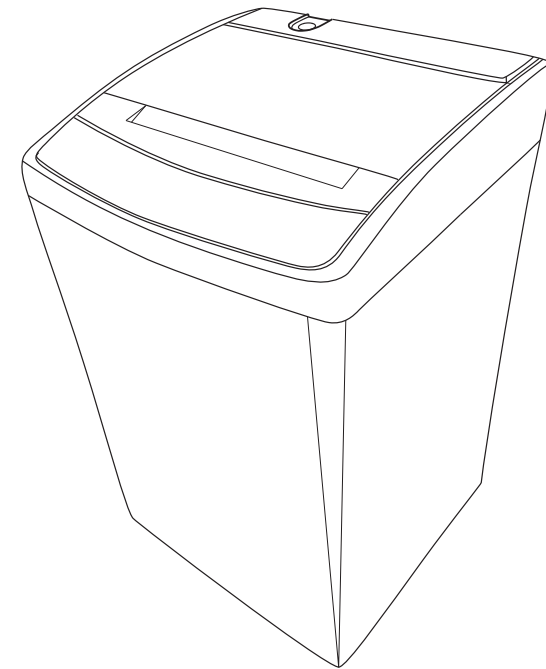

# SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

## ⚠ Warning

- Keep child away from the washing spin tub and do not place box or shelves next to the washing machine. children may fall into the tub resulting in injuries.

This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.



- Do not put your hand into the tub until it has stopped completely.

Even when the spinning of the tub is slow, there is still a danger of being caught in the motion, resulting injuries. Particular attention should be paid when children are around.



- Do not put your hands into the spin tub during the washing and rinsing process.

Even when the spinning is slow, hands may be trapped by clothes. If necessarily, please press pause button, and put your hands into the basket after it has stopped completely.



Prohibited



- Please use the single socket with special voltage and current matched with plug marked specification.

The share of the same socket with other electric appliances may cause fire due to excessive.



Clear

- Thoroughly wipe the power plug when dirt is adhering the prong or around the base of the prong.

Failure to do so may cause a fire.

- Washing machine should not be installed in humid place or in places exposed to wind and rain.

Otherwise, electricity leak causing electric shock or fire may occur.



- This washing machine is strictly prohibited to get close to the locations with candle, mosquito-repellent incense, dog-end or other kinds of open flame.

To avoid injuries caused by the lock damage.



## ⚠ Attention

- Do not pull the wire from the socket when unplugging the unit.

To avoid electric shock or fire caused by short circuit may result.



- Please unplug the unit when not using the unit for a long period of time.

Electric shock or leakage may occur due to deformation of plastic parts of the unit.

- Electricity supply must be unplugged with dry hands during maintenance and repair.

Otherwise, electric leakage causing injuries may occur.

If the power cord or supply cord is damaged, the manufacturer or its service agent or similarly qualified person must replace it in order to avoid a hazard.

- Do not use hot water above 50 °C.

Hot water may cause plastic parts to deform and damage the unit.



# SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

## ⚠ Attention

- Do not wash, rinse and spin the water proof fabric or cloth.

Sleeping bag, raincoat, cover of skiing, utilities, bicycles, cars and motors. Otherwise may lead to injury by abnormal vibration during spinning or damage the washing machine, wall, floor and clothes.



Prohibited

- Do not stand on or put weight on the top of the unit.

Otherwise, deformation and damage may result causing injuries.



Prohibited

- Keep hands and feet away from the bottom of washing machine when it is operating.

Ports in motion beneath the unit may cause injuries.



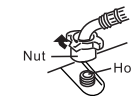

Water leakage

- Water supply hose should be tightly screwed to the unit.

Failure to do so may result in water leakage. Used for a long period of time, the unit may result in water leakage caused by loosen union nut. So please check it in time and screw tightly again.



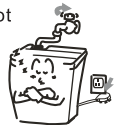
Water leakage

- Check water supply hose connection by turning on the water before washing. To prevent damages caused by possible water leakage due to loosen screw.

- The new hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and that old hose-sets should not be reused.
- Do not block the ventilation openings on the bottom of washer by carpeting when the washer is installed on a carpeted floor.

- Please turn off the water tap when not using the unit.

To prevent damages caused by water leakage.



# CARE AND MAINTENANCE

## Cleaning washing machine

Use soft clothing to wipe off the water or dirt on the surface of the washer.

- Do not spray water directly to the washer body.
- Detergent, propellant and other chemicals are not allowed to use to avoid the damages on the surface.



## Cleaning water inlet valve

(It is suggested to do cleaning once every 6 months)

After long time use, The water inlet mesh bag may be blocked with crud, please load off the water inlet hose, take out the water inlet mesh bag from the water inlet valve, clean the mesh bag, then assemble the mesh bag in the valve and load the water inlet hose.

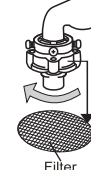


Water Inlet

## Cleaning Universal connector

(It is suggested to do cleaning once every 6 months)

1. Pull the water inlet hose out.
2. Turn off the revolver according to the figure shown.
3. Load off the Universal connector filter and clean the crud with a toothbrush.
4. Install the clean Universal connector filter to revolver and water inlet hose.



Filter







## Cleaning lint filter

(It is suggested to do cleaning once every week)

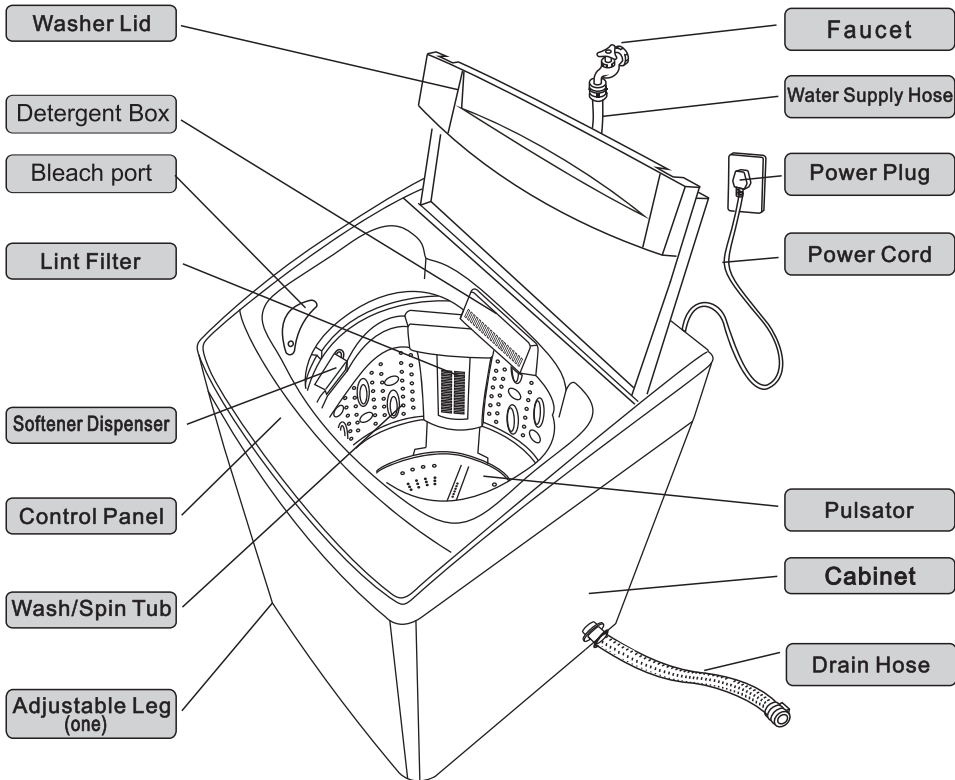
1. Take out the lint filter.
2. Pull out the scraps and wash the lint filter in the water.
3. Install the Filter (aim the frame claw to the groove below).

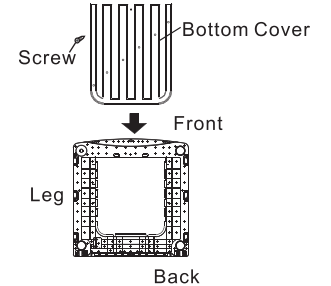

# HOW TO INSTALL

## Installing the Bottom Cover

1. Unplug the power cord of the washer.
2. Gently lay down the backside of washer on a soft mat or cushion. (Be careful not to dent the cabinet)
3. Insert the attached Bottom Cover into the hooks of Leg by straightly pushing until it reaches into the front hooks.
4. Fasten the Bottom Cover with a screw.
5. Gently set the washer upright.



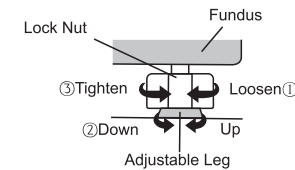
## Location of Washer

1. Avoid place where the machine is exposed to direct sunlight.
2. Install the washer on a stable and level surface.



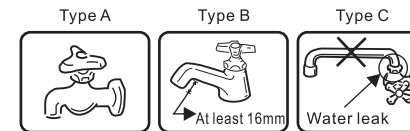
3. Adjust the Adjustable Leg of washer if necessary to make the washer level as shown in the figure.

- The maximum permissible inclination of the supporting surface is 2°.



## Attaching The Universal Connector To a Faucet

Faucet: Type A :is the most suitable



- Type B :The length of the mouth of the faucet needs to be at least 16mm. If it is less than 16mm, the Universal connector can not be installed.
- Type C :It may cause water leaking.

## CAUTIONS:

- Do not use hot water above 50°C.
- If your faucet is not suitable, please consult your dealer.



# HOW TO INSTALL

## How to Attach the Universal connector

1. Separate the Universal connector and the Water Supply Hose by holding the Universal connector in one hand and pressing the Lock Lever in another hand.
2. If the outer diameter of the tap is larger than the calibre of the Joint Ring, loosen the four screws and remove the Joint Ring from the Universal connector.
3. Loosen the four screws and slide the top of the Universal connector onto the tap while making the two screws against the wall contact the tap fully first.
4. Securely tighten the four screws provided with the Universal connector by using a screwdriver to secure the top of the joint to the tap.
5. Remove the CAUTION label from the Universal connector.

## Connecting the Water Supply Hose to the Universal connector

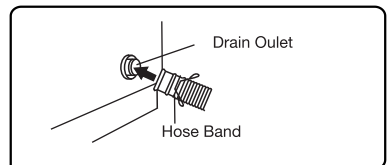
1. Turn the nut clockwise while holding the hose.
2. Turn the nut counter-clockwise after turning the tap off when you want to detach the water supply hose.
3. Make sure inlet hose is properly connected.
  - While pushing the sleeve on the female coupler of the joint down with your fingers, connect the female coupler to the male coupler.
  - Release the sleeve, then push the Water Supply Hose up into the Universal connector until it clicks into place.
  - Pull the Water Supply Hose down to make sure that it is securely attached.

## How to detach the Water Supply Hose

1. Turn the tap off.
  2. Press POWER ON/OFF button to turn on power, then press the START/PAUSE button.
  3. Press the POWER ON/OFF button to turn power off 15 seconds later.
  4. While pushing the lock lever and the sleeve on the female of the joint down with your fingers, detach the female coupler from the male coupler.
  5. Turn the water inlet hose anti-clockwise, till it gets detached.

## Installing the Drain Hose

Place the clip part of the Hose Band sideways to prevent it from touching the frame which may cause a vibration noise.



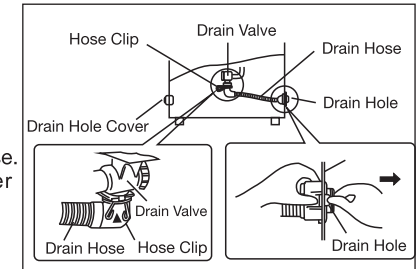
# HOW TO INSTALL

## Changing the Drain Hose direction

You can change the direction from right side to left side.

- Unplug the Power Cord of the washer when changing the Drain Hose direction.
- Put gloves on to Prevent injury of your hands.

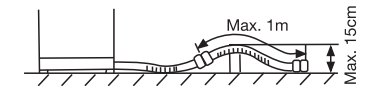
1. Detach the Cap from the left side of the frame.
2. Put down the washer backward on a soft cushion.
3. Loosen the Hose Band and pull the inner Drain Hose out of the Drain Valve. Pull the Hose Band out of the inner Drain Hose.
4. Push the Drain Outlet, pull out the inner Drain Hose from the right hole.
5. Stick the inner Drain Hose into the left hole and attach it to the Drain Outlet securely.
6. Connect the inner Drain Hose to the Drain Valve in place and fix the Hose Band.
7. Attach the Cap to the right hole.
8. Re-attach Back Cover and gently set the washer upright.



## Extension of the Drain Hose

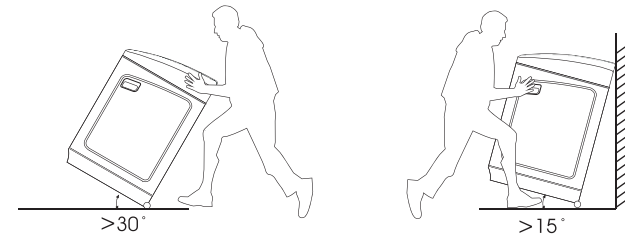
When extending the external Drain Hose, please follow the below figure for the length and height.

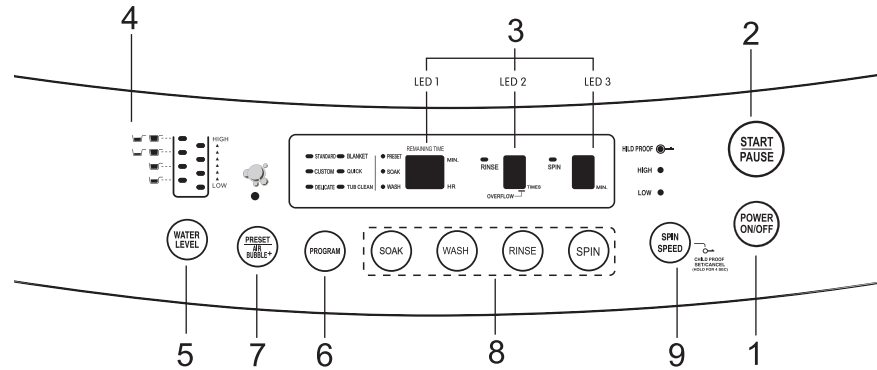


## TO USE ROLLER

- Roller will help you to move the washing machine more easily. To move the washing machine, hold the rear part and tilt the machine, push or pull forward by holding your hand on both sides of the machine.
- Do not use roller on uneven floor to avoid roller damage.
- Do not tilt the machine with strong force to avoid personal injury.



# CONTROL PANEL FUNCTIONS



## 1. "POWER ON/OFF"

Turn power on by pressing this button, press again to turn off. After turn on, power will off automatically if idle for 10 minutes. After washing course finish, power will turn off in 5 sec.

## 2. "START/PAUSE"

Turn power on, press this button to start washing. Press this button again machine will stop running. To resume, press again this button.

## 3. INTRODUCTION OF LED DISPLAY

### LED 1

-After machine start running, LED 1 will show remaining wash time.

E.g. 18 minutes remaining. 18

-LED 1 display how many hours remaining for preset mode to complete.

-LED 1 display soak time and wash time during process setting .

-LED 1 display error code when error occur.

### LED 2

-LED 2 display rinse times.

### LED 3

-LED 3 display spin times.

## 4. DETERGENT

Use recommended amount of detergent according to water level.

## 5. WATER LEVEL

Press this button to choose appropriate water level. Both WASH and RINSE course can choose different water level separately. First and second lowest water level are not available for DELICATE course.

# CONTROL PANEL FUNCTIONS

## 6. "PROGRAM"

-There are 6 auto programs "STANDARD", "CUSTOM", "DELICATE", "BLANKET", "QUICK" and "TUB CLEAN".

-If the "STANDARD", "CUSTOM", "QUICK" and "BLANKET" program is chosen, the washer will automatically judge proper water level and flowrate.

## 7. "PRESET/AIR BUBBLE+"

-To set the finishing time of preset mode.

-Press this button, the "PRESET" indicator will flash, and LED 1 will display the preset hours.

-For "DELICATE" and "TUB CLEAN" programs, the preset does not function.

-Press this button until the "AIR BUBBLE+" indicator light up, indicating the Air Bubble function is activated. To restore, repeat the above step.

## 8. "PROCESS"

-You can set soak time, wash time, rinse times and spin time by these buttons.

-Before start, press "SOAK" button, you can set 0-40 min of soak time. (This cannot function for "DELICATE" and "TUB CLEAN" programs.)

-During washing and rinsing processes, you may press "SOAK" button to adjust the washing flow.

-The indicator of each process will flash while running.

## 9. "SPIN SPEED"

-Press this button, to set spinning speed. This button can also be used to set "CHILD PROOF" function. See details in "CHILD PROOF" function.

## STANDARD USE

### 1. PREPARATION

- Install the drain hose to machine.
  - Connect the inlet hose to the faucet and turn on the faucet. Before turning on the faucet, please make sure the connection is firm. If the inlet hose is not firmly connected to the faucet, there may be water leakage.
  - Connect plug to socket.
  - Put clothing into washer.
2. Press "POWER ON/OFF" button
3. Press "START/PAUSE" button
- The sensor will automatically judge clothing weight for programs "STANDARD", "CUSTOM", "BLANKET" and "QUICK".
  - The washer will automatically choose water flow, water level.
4. Please use proper amount of detergent according to table below.
5. Close the washer lid.
- If the washer lid is not closed, the washer will stop before start spinning, and buzzer sound will on.

- Too much detergent causes poor rinsing and too little detergent causes poor washing

## HOW TO SET CUSTOMIZED PROGRAM

### 1. PREPARATION

- Install the drain hose. Connect the inlet hose to the faucet and turn on the faucet. Connect plug to socket. Put clothing into washer.
2. Press "POWER ON/OFF" button
3. Choose the program according to the type of clothing.

## HOW TO SET CUSTOMIZED PROGRAM

4. By pressing process buttons, you can set desired soak time, wash time, rinse time, and spin time. During the setting, the LED will display as follows:

-Preset time display:

0→1→2→...→5→6→...→24 (hours)  
 ↑ (Preset does not function for DELICATE function.)

-Soak time display:

0→5→10→15→...→40 (minutes)  
 ↑ (Soak does not function for DELICATE function.)

-Wash time display:

0→1→2→...→9→10→...→20 (minutes)  
 ↑

-Rinse times display:

0→1→1.→2→2.→3→3.→4→4. times  
 ↑ (The number means times and "." means Overflow Rinse)

-Spin time display:

0→1→2→...→5→6→...→9 (minutes)  
 ↑ (for STANDARD, CUSTOM, BLANKET, QUICK)

0→1→2→3 (minutes)  
 ↑ (for DELICATE)

Note: TUB CLEAN function has default setting of 8th water level, and all processes cannot be adjusted.

-To set one unique process: press PROGRAM button to select STANDARD, then press WASH, RINSE or SPIN button to set WASH ONLY, RINSE ONLY or SPIN ONLY.

5. Press WATER LEVEL button to select proper water level and then put detergent in.

6. Press "START/PAUSE" button and close the washer lid.

7. To reset, turn off the washer and turn on again by pressing "POWER ON/OFF" button.

## HOW TO USE DELICATE WASH

- Please check the care label before you wash woolen material.
- When this program is set, the water level will be set at 6 automatically. However you can change the water level to 3~8 according to the load size of your clothes.

### OPERATION

1. Turn on the faucet, press POWER ON/OFF button and open the wash lid.
  2. Press PROGRAM button to select DELICATE.
  3. Put liquid detergent, dissolved powder detergent with 5L warm water, (about 30°C) into the washer.
  4. Put clothes into the washer.
  5. Press START/PAUSE button. If necessary, you can adjust the water level.
  6. Close the washer lid.
- If the washer lid is not closed, the washer will stop automatically before spinning. The buzzer will buzz at the end of washing, and power will be automatically off in 5 sec. Turn off the faucet and clean the filter.

#### Note:

- Clothes weight should be less than 1.5kg for DELICATE.
- After wash, please remove the clothes for hanging to avoid prolonged stay and deformation.
- PRESET does not function here.
- The water temperature should be less than 30 °C.
- Please wash white, colorful, and dark color clothes separately.

## ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

### PRESET

- It is used to delay the finishing time of the operation.
- Before PRESET, turn on the faucet, connect the drain hose, and make sure the connection of water inlet hose to the faucet is firm to avoid water leakage.

#### OPERATION

1. Press POWER ON/OFF button.
  2. Press PROCESS or PROGRAM to select your desired program.
  3. Press PRESET to select the time. LED will display finishing time. Press one more time, the time will be added by 1 hour. The longest is 24 hours.
  4. Press WATER LEVEL to select proper water level. Put detergent and softener in.
  5. Press START/PAUSE button.
  6. Close the wash lid.
- Except for PRESET light, all other lights will off after one minute. If CHILD PROOF function is set, the CHILD PROOF light will be on as well.
  - For "DELICATE" and "TUB CLEAN" programs, the preset does not function.
  - If you need to check the remaining time, press any button except for POWER ON/OFF.
  - If you need to change the preset process, press POWER ON/OFF, repeat the above.
  - The PRESET will be cancelled if washer is unplugged or there is power failure.

## ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

### MEMORY

- The programs "STANDARD", "CUSTOM" and "BLANKET" will be remembered after ending. For next use, turn on power, the washer will display the process of last time. Press START/PAUSE button, to start.
- The washer cannot remember "PRESET" and "WATER LEVEL".
  - For "STANDARD" and "BLANKET" programs, the washer can only remember default programs, while for "CUSTOM", the washer can remember manual setting data, like wash time, rinse times and spin time.

### INTELLIGENT WASH

- In order to increase wash efficiency, the washer will start washing when water reaches 2 levels less than set water level, at the same time, the water continues to flow in.
- INTELLIGENT WASH is not available for DELICATE and TUB CLEAN. It is not working if 1st or 2nd lowest water level is chosen.
  - If SOAK is set, there is no INTELLIGENT WASH function.

### WATER LEVEL CHANGE

- You can set the water level for wash and rinse processes. For example, if you are sensitive to detergent residues, you may want to select a higher water level for rinse in your wash.

To set different water level:

- Press the WASH button until the WASH indicator flashes; press the WATER LEVEL button to choose the proper water level; press the WASH button to set the wash time.
- Press the RINSE button until the RINSE indicator flashes; press the WATER LEVEL button to choose the proper water level; press the RINSE button to set the number of rinses.
- Press the SPIN button until the SPIN indicator flashes; press the SPIN button to choose the spin time.
- Press the START/PAUSE button to start wash.

### CHILD PROOF

This function avoids child open the washer lid.

To set the child proof:

Press POWER ON/OFF, and keep on pressing SPIN SPEED button for 4 seconds until a buzzer sound. The child proof will be activated when the START/PAUSE button is pressed. Repeat the steps to cancel.

With CHILD PROOF mode, the child proof indicator will be on. If the washer lid is open for more than 4 seconds during washer running, the washer will stop running with E5 error display buzzer will keep beeping.

### DELETE THE END BUZZER

Press POWER ON/OFF, and keep pressing START/PAUSE button for more than 4 seconds till a sound from buzzer. To restore, repeat the above steps.

## ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS

### DRAINING

Once set, the drain valve opens automatically 9 minutes after machine stops. The remaining water drains to avoid freezing (under 0°C). "Ud" displays on Control Panel.  
SETTING METHOD

Press POWER ON/OFF, and Keep pressing "SPIN" for more than 5 seconds until a beep sounds. To recover, repeat the above steps.

### TUB CLEAN

This function is to clean the surfaces of outer tub and inner tub. It is suggested to clean every 6 months.

1. Press POWER ON/OFF
2. Put specific detergent or disinfectant product for tub clean into the tub.
3. Press PROGRAM to select TUB CLEAN.
4. Press START/PAUSE.

Note:

- The default water level is the highest one.
  - The whole cleaning process takes about 1 hour.
- The water level button and other buttons cannot work.

### AIR BUBBLE+

In order to enhance the cleaning performance, during the washing process, the AIR BUBBLE+ generator is generating air bubble.  
Press "POWER ON/OFF" button, and press "AIR BUBBLE+" button until a beep sounds, AIR BUBBLE+ indicator will light up, indicating that this function has activate. To restore, repeat the above steps.  
(After machine starts, the "AIR BUBBLE+" function is automatically started)

## TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

When the following problems occur, the microcomputer will detect the abnormal condition and an electronic buzzer beeps for approximately 10 seconds and the indicators flash as shown below.

## NON-FAULT PHENOMENON

1. During wash or rinse, if water flows in, this is possibly caused by automatic water supplement due to low water level.
2. When spinning, the tub rotates discontinuously. This is intermittent spinning designed for better spin effect.
3. Draining does not happen during rinse. This may be caused by low water level or pressure.
4. Sometimes you may notice that water flows during spin. This is because the machine is correcting the unbalanced load automatically.
5. After spin ends, one may hear sound as if water flows. This is specially designed to reduce vibration in spin by a balance liquid in balancing ring.
6. The machine has to be reset upon restoration of power, after power failure.

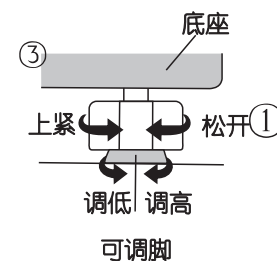
### 底盖板的安装

### 万能接头的安装

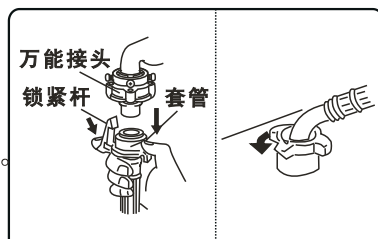
- 一手拿着万能接头，一手按住锁紧杆，将万能接头与进水软管分开。  

- 如果水龙头的直径大于万能接头中环垫的内径，请先松开万能接头上的螺钉，将环垫取出。

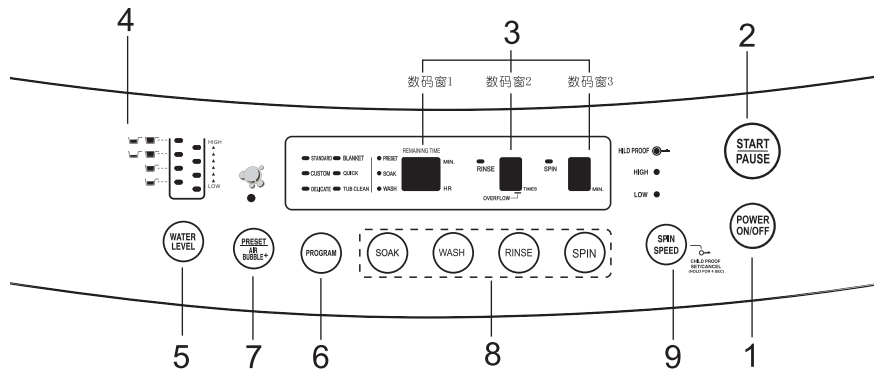
### 滚轮的使用方法及其注意事项



使用移动滚轮来帮助您将洗衣机搬运到想要的位置。

- 请您位于洗衣机后侧，用手按在面架后部，将洗衣机倾斜后，按着机器两侧向前推动或向后拉动洗衣机。
- 移动滚轮搬运中不适于凹凸不平的地面，易造成移动滚轮损坏。
- 倾斜洗衣机时请勿用力过猛，易造成洗衣机倾斜而造成人身伤害。

## 控制面板功能介绍



### 1. “电源开/关”键



### 操作顺序

1. 拧开水龙头，按下“电源开/关”键并打开洗涤上盖。
2. 按“程序”键，直到“柔顺”灯亮为止。
3. 将液体洗涤剂倒入洗衣机，如您使用洗衣粉，将其充分溶解在5L的温水中（大约30℃），然后慢慢地倒入洗衣机中。

### 取消蜂鸣声

### 排残水功能

设置后，在程序结束9分钟后，排水阀自动打开，排出机内残留的水，防止天冷时冻结。（在气温低于0℃时使用）。排残水功能作用时，数码框显示“Ud”。

按“电源开/关”键，按住“脱水”键4秒以上，直到听到蜂鸣提示音为止。恢复时，重复上述操作。

### 洁桶功能

本程序是对洗衣机内外桶的回转盘内表面进行清洗、杀菌。  
（专功能是对桶的清洗，建议6个月进行一次）

操作顺序：

1. 按“电源开/关”键
2. 在洗衣桶内加入专用清洗剂或消毒液，并盖好洗衣上盖。
3. 按“程序”键选择“洁桶”。

  - 水位自动设定为高水位。

  - 此时水位等键均不能设定。

为了提高清洁性能，在洗涤过程中，“超净泡”发生器产生气泡。

- 按下“电源开/关”键，然后按“超净泡”按钮，直到发出哔哔声，“超净泡”灯点亮，表明已启用“超净泡”功能。恢复时，重复上述操作。（洗衣机开机后，“超净泡”功能默认已启动。）

## 并非故障的情况

1. 在洗涤或漂洗时有时有进水现象, 这是由于水位下降而进行的自动补水。
2. 在脱水开始时, 洗涤/脱水桶时停时转, 这是为达到更好的脱水效果而设计的间歇脱水。
3. 注水洗清时, 排水管有不排水现象, 这是由于设定水位较低或水压较小造成的。
4. 脱水中途有时出现进水漂洗现象, 这是由于脱水时衣物偏置而自动进行的脱偏纠正。
5. 脱水结束后, 有水残留的声音, 这是为了降低脱水振动而设计的平衡环内平衡液的流动声。
6. 运转中途停电, 来电后不能自动进行继续运行, 请重新设定。
